December 22, 1923 - April 19, 2017

Bernard (Ben) S. Ferro was born December 22, 1923 in Oakland, California to parents Anthony and Virginia Ferro, and passed away peacefully on April 19, 2017 at the age of 93 with family by his side.

Ben attended Turlock High School, graduating in 1940. He joined the Army after high school serving as a private first class rifleman in the 143rd infantry, receiving a purple heart after being wounded in the Battle of the Bulge.

After his service in the Army, Ben married his wife Olga Kofinow on February 2, 1946 in Turlock, California.

Ben was involved with many organizations, such as the Native Sons of the Golden West, Sons of Italy, B.P.O.E. (Elks), American Legion Post 88, and the Purple Heart Veterans Association.

Ben is survived by his wife Olga Ferro; his son Tom (Darlene) Ferro; his daughter Karen (Jim) Haire; his grandchildren Jon Haire, Amanda (Ben) Hoover, and Teryn Ferro; his great grandchildren D'Angelo, Kailee, Sean, and Rebellanne; and his brother Tony (Mary) Ferro; along with many nieces and nephews.
