David Jamieson McCallum was born in Berkeley, California on January 29, 1955 to Walter and Harriet McCallum and passed away unexpectedly Thursday night, May 29th. Growing up on the Napa farm, David attended Napa schools, was heavily involved in 4-H showing sheep at the Napa Fair and started his life long love affair with music. He was nicknamed "DJ Mac" as he hauled his huge speakers to events and played music to the crowd's pleasure.

He received his AA degree from American River Junior College while working full time for Albertsons in Sacramento. He was living in San Jose and working at Wiltron as a technician when he attended the wedding of the Sheriff's daughter in Napa and met his future wife, Dorothy. He was smitten, moved to Napa, was baptized into the Greek Orthodox faith and then wed in the Vallejo Greek Orthodox on August 16, 1986. He grew to love everything Greek, especially the food. He held several jobs and was adept at anything electronic. He was secretary of the Napa County Mounted Sheriff's Posse and cut quite a striking figure astride Dorothy's horse, Valentino. He donated many hours building Skyline Wilderness Park from the ground up and given a life membership to the Park. He was working there when he suffered a massive stroke in February 2014 which incapacitated him and changed the course of his life. He was a member of Skyline Wilderness Park, Napa Mounted Sheriff's Posse, Napa Valley Horseman's Association and Napa Parlor of the Native Sons of the Golden West.

David was predeceased by his parents and brother, Patrick. He is survived by his wife Dorothy, son Stavros Wagner, sister and brother-in-law Susan and Russ Markistum, sister Judi, nieces Jennifer, Kimberly, Kelly and nephew Corey.

His funeral service will be preformed by Father Nick Mueller (Oakland Greek Orthodox Church) at 11 am on Wednesday, June 4th at the Skyline Wilderness Park Social Hall, 2201 Imola Avenue, Napa with luncheon immediately following.
