Hilda Villegas died July 20, 2014, in Palo Alto. She was born Dec. 21, 1926, in St. Helena. She was active in student affairs and vice president her senior year at St. Helena High School and graduated in 1945. She was the founder of the Hispanic Network of Napa, which provided scholarships to Hispanic-American youth. Hilda worked at the Department of Unemployment for 20 years in Vallejo and Napa offices.

She is survived by her daughters that cared for her, Gloria Zuelow and Cynthia Villegas; and grandchildren Erin, Sergio, Xavier and Cecilia; and great-grandchildren Mateo and Katie.
