She rejoiced in sharing her golden voice with people around her. Leslie's family remembers many holidays when she and her sister sang together.

Her friends remember her warm smile, infectious laughter, and enthusiastic hugs.

In her professional career, she was a pharmaceutical office administrator, known for her remarkable rapport with clients.

In 2011 she began providing care on the weekends for her grandmother and aunt, shopping for groceries and bringing movies over for them to watch together. When her grandmother moved to Tracy, she continued caring for her.

An avid SF Giants fan, she delighted in attending Opening Day with her dad, posting Giants memes on Facebook, watching games at home with her grandmother, and wearing black and orange faithfully.

She loved learning to cook her grandmother's Mexican recipes and made an effort to document them for the family.
