



Pearl Levy

July 10, 1920 - June 4, 2018

Agnes Pearl Levy, known to friends and family as Pearl, died peacefully in her sleep on June 4th at the age of 97. Born in Oakland, California on July 10, 1920, her parents were Manuel and Ludvina Gonsalves, immigrants from the Portuguese island of Madeira. Pearl was the fifth of seven children and is preceded in death by her brothers and sisters.

She moved to Napa at age 10 and graduated Napa High School in 1939. Pearl married Napa native Dorrien B. Levy on January 1, 1941. Pearl and Dorrien enjoyed many activities together, including traveling with the SIRS club; they were both baseball fans and went to many Giants and A's games. Baseball played an enormous role in the Gonsalves home and Pearl was an avid fan. Dorrien passed away in October 1995.

Pearl was a devout Catholic, attending St. Apollinaris Church for over 50 years; she enjoyed being Financial Secretary of the Young Ladies Institute, YLI and was a member of the Native Daughters of the Golden West.

Pearl loved people and was invariably kind and welcoming to everyone she met. The words most used to describe her are "happy" and "sweet." She was an avid bingo player and enjoyed crocheting beautiful afghans, which she gave to her family and friends. They were the most sought-after prizes at charity auctions. Pearl's home was always open to her children's friends.

Pearl is survived by her daughter Barbara Mack and her son Doug Levy, both of Los Angeles; three grandchildren, Jim Mack (Leslie) of Idaho and Emma Levy and Joshua Levy, of Washington. She has one great-granddaughter, Briana Elison (Darius) of Idaho and two great-great granddaughters, Lillian and Vivian Elison, as well as many beloved nieces and nephews.

Recitation of the Rosary will be at Claffey and Rota Funeral Home on June 7, 2018 at 6pm. A funeral Mass will be celebrated on June 8, 2018 at St. Apollinaris Catholic Church at 10:30am. A reception will follow burial at Tulocay Cemetery.
