Ralph Peter Anderson, Jr. passed on Nov. 19, 2014, in Napa. Born on Aug. 23, 1933, in San Francisco, to Ralph and Mary Anderson, Ralph attended St. Ignatius High School and the University of San Francisco. He served in the USMC from 1953 to 1956. After the service, he proudly served for 30 years in the California Highway Patrol, moving frequently before settling in Marin County.

Mr. Anderson married Dolores Briare on Aug. 3, 1957, settling in Novato to raise their eight children. They retired to Napa in 1996, where they enjoyed cooking, gardening and traveling. Ralph was a member of St. Apollinaris Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, San Rafael-Novato Elks, Sons in Retirement-Novato, Napa Yacht Club and Men's Breakfast Club.
