Ramona Violet Erwin (Forman) died Mar. 5, 2014 in Vacaville. She was born in Napa on Aug. 22, 1923; a third generation Napan. She attended Napa High School and worked at the Cameron Shirt Factory and Mare Island Naval Shipyard. She served in the US Navy WAVES (WWII), as a Hospitalman, serving at Alameda Air Station and Mare Island Naval Hospital. She was a long time member and parish volunteer of Saint John's Catholic parish.

Ramona and her husband Daniel G. Erwin Sr. moved to Vacaville from Napa in 2004 residing at Merrill Gardens, a senior community. She was a member of the Red Hat Society, enjoyed bingo, was a book club member. She was on the communities Wii Bowling Team. 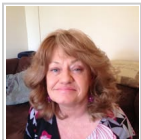
