Robert Burtch Rogers passed away peacefully on March 11, 2013. A long-time resident of Salinas, CA, Robert was a public school teacher and guidance counselor at Washington Junior High School. He was born in New Orleans, LA, attended Louisiana State University, was a naval aviator serving active duty in the South Pacific during WWII. and continued naval service in the Mediterranean after the war.
